Note from Pastor Rich

Our synod assembly was held June 1 and 2. Bethel belongs to a larger group of churches called the Eastern North Dakota Synod of the Evangelical Lutheran Church in America (ELCA).

We are most familiar with our own ministries, worship, daily and weekly work of being part of God's word and work in this part of God's world. And we work alongside 180 other ELCA congregations in the synod. Check it out! www.eandsynod.org.

The English word "synod" (sounds like: sin'id; with the short-i sound as in "in") comes from two words in Greek. (An aside: the earliest written manuscripts of the New Testament [good news about Jesus!] were written in Greek; thus the use of some Greek words in the self-identification of the church.) The two Greek words are syn and hodos, which mean, "a way together."

Some may ask: Why be part of a synod? What's the big deal? The big deal is in the word synod: a way together. Think summer driving. A traveling partner who 1) can maneuver around construction sites by knowing which roads are limited or closed, 2) knows which traffic patterns are busiest and slowest, and 3) has a keen awareness of the best times to travel, is the kind of driver I want to be with in the car!

So too, with congregations, synods, and the ELCA. We can be in conversation with other congregations (i.e.: synod) about ways we see Jesus impacting people for their well-being through our ministry. We can listen to guidance from other congregations who've travelled the "church work and world way" before we have. We share our insights in ministry. We gain insights from others: good traveling partners on the way of following Jesus and serving so that others may follow Jesus, too.
