Brothers and sisters in Christ, in Holy Baptism, Jesus received you and made you members of his church. In the community of God's people, you have learned about God's loving purpose for you and all creation. You have been called to be witnesses to the Gospel of Jesus Christ.

Confirmands: Today we profess our faith in Jesus Christ and confess the faith in which we have been baptized.

(The congregation is invited to stand and join the confirmands in the profession of our shared Christian faith.)

#### **Declaration of Faith**

Do you renounce all the forces of evil, the devil, and all his empty promises?

I do.

Do you believe in God the Father?

I believe in God the Father almighty, creator of heaven and earth.

Do you believe in Jesus Christ, the Son of God?

I believe in Jesus Christ, his only Son, our Lord. He was conceived by the power of the Holy Spirit and born of the virgin Mary. He

suffered under Pontius Pilate, was crucified, died, and was buried. He descended into hell. On the third day he rose again. He ascended into heaven, and is seated at the right hand of the Father. He will come again to judge the living and the dead.

Do you believe in God the Holy Spirit?

I believe in the Holy Spirit, the holy catholic Church, the communion of saints, the forgiveness of sins, the resurrection of the body, and the life everlasting. Amen.

#### **Declaration of Intent**

You have made public professions of your faith. Do you intend to continue in the covenant God made with you in Holy Baptism: to live among God's faithful people, to hear his Word and share in his supper, to proclaim the good news of God in Christ through word and deed, to serve all people, following the example of our Lord Jesus, and to strive for justice and peace in all the earth?

Confirmands: I do, and I ask God to help and guide me.
